AWARD DESCRIPTIONS

Police Cross

A medal awarded to the family of an officer who lost his or her life in the performance of duty under honorable circumstances.

Police Medal of Valor

A medal awarded for extraordinary heroism at imminent risk of serious bodily injury or death, with the recipient demonstrating courage by performing a voluntary course of action in an extremely dangerous situation.

James J. Wade Most Outstanding Officer of the Year Award

Awarded for exceptional achievement, including crime prevention and community programs, detective work, drug and youth programs, training programs, traffic safety or innovative approaches to public service.

Certificate of Recognition

Awarded to individuals who, by their actions or deeds in support of law enforcement or public safety, merit recognition by the Illinois Association of Chiefs of Police.

Outstanding Citizen Award

Awarded for a significant contribution to law enforcement in Illinois.

Criminal Investigator of the Year Award

In recognition of those detectives or investigators who are often not recognized for solving cases yet are important in the investigation of all types of cases.

Life Saving Award

A medal awarded to all sworn or non-sworn police personnel directly responsible for the prolonging or saving of a human life.

Meritorious Unit Citation Award

Units/Task Forces who perform an act or a series of acts during the year of the award which demonstrate a high degree of teamwork and professionalism which result in the attainment of the unit's mission goals in an exemplary manner.

Ten Shared Principles Award

The award is designed to recognize a commitment to and notable, demonstrable achievement in supporting or advocating for the Ten Shared Principles of Public Safety during the preceding calendar year.

Citizen Award Certificate

Awarded certificate for action that merits attention and commendation.

Laurence P. Mulcrone Private Security Partnership Award

Recognizes the commitment to safety and collaboration by the private security industry in Illinois.
