

PRELIMINARY FIELD MEDICAL SCREENING

The purpose of conducting this preliminary field medical screening of an arrestee is to prevent the exposure and spread of high risk contagious viral respiratory antigens.

If an arrestee displays positive signs or reports positive symptoms of a respiratory infection, take appropriate safety precautions, and transport the arrestee directly to a hospital for medical clearance for booking. Call the hospital before arrival, and advise the staff of the arrestee's condition.
