


## WHO ARE WE?

The Illinois Funeral Assistance Team was formulated to assist all law enforcement departments, within the State of Illinois, with police related deaths. The Illinois Chiefs of Police and the Illinois Chapter of Concerns of Police Survivors (C.O.P.S.) have partnered together to provide support to families of our fallen law enforcement professionals and to the agency that suffers a loss. Through the 24-hour notification system, any Illinois law enforcement agency can request the support of a trained team specializing in funeral operations and family support. This team can reduce the draw on an agencies resources in supporting a law enforcement related funeral and allow the officers of the fallen to mourn.

Resources include assistance in planning police funerals, honor guard/color guard protocols, rifle teams, and family support information.

The C.O.P.S. organization also provides representation to both the survivors of Illinois officers and the families of officers from across the country who call Illinois home.
